

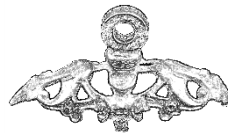

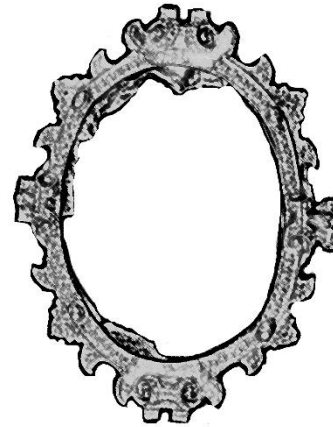

Artifact Comments: Artifact from the Contadora section of the San Jose site. The assorted ornate Jewelry pieces were recovered in two separate excavation. Tag # 00176-1 and 00177-1 were in the same excavation while Tag# 00545-1 was recovered at a distance of 71 meters with a degree heading of 45 Degrees. The presumed (Reliquary) is apparently missing a minimum of three additional pieces as well as the presumed crystal or glass that would have encapsulated the relic inside. All pieces had light gorgonian concretion deposits and was found in an area with other assorted jewelry Item, all in restively the same state and damaged condition. The area is approximately 68.5. Meters in length with a basic heading of 34 degrees, Depth at low tide is under 4.5 Meters and is heavily affected by wave action. The highly dynamic environment and rocky bottom conditions could have possibly been a factor of the artifacts damaged recovery condition.
